WHO IS THE PCMCA?

- PCMCA is a non- profit Association to promote the sport of curling through fun and competitive events both at the Club and Provincial level. It represents approximately 2,300 Master Curlers (60 years by Dec 31) on Vancouver Island and the Lower Mainland
- There are 4 Zones
- Northern Vancouver Island Zone 4 Qualicum, Comox, Parksville & Nanaimo
- Southern Vancouver Island Zone 1 Duncan, Esquimalt,
 Kerry Park & Victoria
- Vancouver and area Zone 3 Marpole, North Shore, Port Moody, Richmond, Royal City, Tunnel Town & Vancouver
- Fraser Valley Zone 2 Abbotsford, Chilliwack, Cloverdale, Delta Thistle, Golden Ears, Langley, Mission & Peach Arch

WHAT DOES THE PCMCA DO FOR YOU?

- Allows you to support fellow "club curlers" and yourselves to compete at Zone Playdowns and ultimately at a Provincial Combined Championship
- These annual Playdowns and Championships are as much a Social event as it is Competitive one
- Most of the cost to partake in the Combined Championship is funded by the PCMCA and your Zone. This cost is significantly lower than any Curl BC playdowns
- Financially supports Masters events within your Zone
- Supports your clubs by renting ice for Playdowns
- Creates Bar and Concession revenues during these events

What's involved:

- · Divisions includes:
 - Men's 60+ (Guy Philip), 70+ (Donaldson)
 - Ladies 60+
 - Mixed 60+
 - Stick 60+ (New in 2023)
 - 80+ Men's, Ladies, Stick, Wheelchair ... (New for 2024)
- ➤ Each affiliated club is permitted 2 teams per division. If more than 2 teams have entered, the club will need to hold a playoff.
- > Teams must enter by December 31, 2024
- > Entry forms will be posted at your club
- > Teams must all come from the same club and players must be affiliated with the PCMCA
- > Entry fees are \$50 per player
- ➤ Zone 4 Playdowns for 2024 will be at Parksville in February. Dates to be determined.
- ➤ Winners of the Zone 4 playdowns will compete held at the Combined Championship in Langley/Cloverdale – March 24th to 28th, 2025
- ➤ This Championship involves 3 games against teams within the PCMCA then 4 Games against BCIMCA teams thus the name Combined Championship.

BRITISH COLUMBIA INTERIOR MASTERS CURLING ASSOCIATION (BCIMCA)
